Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is a COVID-19 Event Checker?

A: The COVID-19 Event Checker's responsibility is to ensure that all pre-event COVID-19 protocols are adhered to by event organisers for all events being held under the authority of a Motorsport Australia Organising Permit.

It is also the responsibility of the COVID-19 Checker to ensure ongoing compliance with COVID-19 protocols throughout the event.

Q: How do I access the Motorsport Australia Return to Race resources?

Q: What happens if protocols are not adhered to?

A: If protocols are not being adhered to at any stage before competition commences or during the event, the COVID-19 Checker must advise the Stewards who will promptly instruct the Clerk of the Course to cease competition until such time that the breach is rectified.

Q: Do I need to have a Motorsport Australia Officials or Competitors licence?

A: It is preferable but not essential.

If the COVID-19 Event Checker holds an Officials or Competitors licence, they will have a better understanding of, and access to, Motorsport Australia policies and procedures.

Q: Does the personal accident insurance apply if I contract COVID-19 at the event?

A: The Personal Accident policy will not apply to participants or voluntary workers (including officials) if they were to contract COVID-19 whilst attending a Motorsport Australia sanctioned event as this policy is for 'Accidental Injury' only, not illness, as has always been the case.

Q: What experience do I need to have to be a COVID-19 Event Checker?

A: You don't need any experience to be an Event Checker however it is preferred that you have at least a Bronze level Officials or Competitors licence.

You do need to have an understanding of the motorsport environment, can follow process and are confident liaising with the Event Organiser and Event Command Officials.

Q: Can I fulfill multiple roles at the Event?

A: Depending on the level of event:

- Club/Multi Club – Yes you can fulfill another role as well as being the COVID-19 Event Checker
- State – Yes however it is preferred that your sole responsibility is that of the COVID-19 Event Checker
- National – No, your sole responsibility should be that of the COVID-19 Event Checker
