#### MATTERS ARISING AT MEETING

##### 5<sup>TH</sup> CATEGORY CARS PARTICIPATING IN A CONTEMPORARY MEETING

The Commission advises that Promoters of 5<sup>th</sup> Category Cars at a Contemporary Race Meeting need to obtain approval of the AHMSC for the involvement of these cars at a meeting.

##### Min 2140: CARBON FIBRE TUBS

Research by a Working Group on full carbon tub cars continues, with enquiries to the FIA for any procedures adopted by that body.

##### Min 2142: HISTORIC EQUIPMENT CHART

The Historic Equipment Chart is now on the CAMS website for use as a 'guideline'; it is subject to review at any time.

##### Min 2143: GROUP A & C FUEL

The Commission has accepted the following, which has been referred to the CAMS Fuels Regulations Committee for consideration:

*"(a) Engine*

*(v) Fuel: Only Pump Fuel or Unleaded Racing Fuel to a maximum rating of 104RON/90MON & 3.7% oxygen volume as defined by Schedule G of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport are permitted Specific requirements additional to the General Requirements (Group C):*

*(a) Engine*

*(iv) Fuel: Only Pump Fuel or Unleaded Racing Fuel to a maximum rating of 104RON/90MON & 3.7% oxygen volume as defined by Schedule G of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport are permitted."*

### Min 2148: GROUP O TYRES - HOOSIER

The Commission approved Hoosier's latest tyre for Formula B class vehicles to be placed on the Group O Tyre List in order to fill the void of other tyre manufacturers' size options. These tyres will be made with the track tested R35B tread compound and will be available from local distributors. Effective as from 1/1/20.

### Min 2150: HISTORIC FORMULA FORD FUEL REQUIREMENTS AS OF 1/1/20

A proposal was presented to the Commission to mandate only pump 98 (unleaded petrol) and only lead substitutes that do not provide any octane booster are permissible for all Historic Formula Ford Cars (Group F) as of 1/1/20.

Allowing the option of a fuel other than pump 98 and only lead substitutes that do not provide any octane booster could adversely impact on participation numbers. The high cost of specially blended fuels would place competing out of range for the majority of competitors and also see the competition broken into two groups - those that can afford to pay for the power gain and those that cannot. This was the experience when the fuel was not specified pre-2015.

Mandating the use of pump 98 (unleaded) only and lead substitutes that do not provide any octane booster will ensure the competition will remain the same and not disadvantage drivers with smaller budgets. Pump 98 is also very easy to test for compliance and also easier to purchase.

The following change will be made to Schedule F of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport to read:  
"Group F – Formula Ford Racing Cars

Specific requirements additional to the General Requirements:

.....

(g) Fuel: Only pump fuel as per Schedule G:

- only those lead replacement additives as listed and permitted in Schedule G;
- any fuel containing ethanol (excluding E10, E85) is prohibited."
