RISK AND SAFETY ISSUES

In November 2017 the Commission determined to mandate the use of Frontal Head Restraints in Speed Events for the following vehicles:

- First category vehicles;
- Vehicles with CAMS compliant safety seat, safety harness and roll over protection system. These vehicles can be considered as those Log Booked vehicles that participate in other discipline events whereby the use of FHR is already mandatory, such as Race and Rally events.

The Commission has further discussed the matter to clarify the requirements for the CAMS Technical Department to prepare the regulatory wording for the Commission to approve and forward to the CAMS Board for ratification, and the final determination of the implementation time frame.
