RISK AND SAFETY ISSUES

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR)

The Commission has approved of the presentation to the CAMS Board to mandate the use of Frontal Head Restraints in Speed Events for the following vehicles:

- First category vehicles;
- Vehicles with CAMS compliant safety seat, safety harness and roll over protection system.

The recommendation to the Board is to be effective as from 1/1/20 (not 1/1/9 as previously advised).

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Min 0356 SUPERSPRINT NATIONAL REGULATIONS

The Commission's Speed Working Group (SEWG) has recommended to the Commission:

Standing Regulations

These regulations are satisfactory for the purpose they are used for and Standing Regulations are not required.

Supplementary Regulations

The SEWG noted that CAMS currently provides a Proforma for Supplementary Regulations for Speed Events (refer to Get Involved>Events>Event Forms on the CAMS website) and this provision is of service to new event organisers; however, given the wide variety of events conducted the mandatory use of such a template would impact on the level of detail required to be included for some events. As such the SEWG considered the current practice of providing the proforma regulations for those who wish to use it is fine, whilst those with the skill and experience can provide their own complete document.

The standard national classes must be included as a minimum, although additional classes are permitted.

Min 0357 KHANACROSS REGULATIONS

The Sporting Regulations have now been drafted and are to be re-presented to the Auto Working Group (AWG) for finalisation and then they will be effective as from 1/1/19. As soon as available they will be issued for the interest of event organisers.

The Vehicle Technical Regulations (to be known as Group 4K) will now be drafted.

Min 0359 CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT POLICY

The Policy has now been finalised and passed by the CAMS Board; it can be found on the CAMS website at CAMS>About>Policies>CAMS Championship and Series Policy.

Min 0362 SAFETY REQUIREMENTS OF OPEN VEHICLES AT SPEED EVENTS

The Commission has expanded this review to cover all Open Vehicles for Speed events and the matter is ongoing.
