#### SAFETY AND RISK ISSUES

##### Frontal Head Restraints

The Commission discuss potential loopholes in Schedule D (at Article 1.4) and has referred the matter to the Administration for clarification.

#### MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

##### Min 0394: DRIFTING – STANDING REGULATIONS

These regulations have been completed and are now on the website.

##### MIN 0395: KHANACROSS REGULATIONS

These regulations only require the replacement of the tyres article and will then be available for issue. Given that many Khanacross Championships have commenced already for 2019 – if cars are now required to comply with these regulations it may cause some issues should any have competed to date that don't.

As such, these published regulations may be used (with the organiser's acceptance) for the 2019 CAMS AUS Khanacross Championship this year and will then apply from 1st January 2020.



## AUSTRALIAN MOTOR SPORT DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

### **Min 0396: SAFETY REQUIREMENTS OF OPEN TOP VEHICLES AT SPEED EVENTS**

The Commission continues to assess safety requirements for open top vehicles at various Speed Event disciplines and will be working on this issue throughout 2019.

### **Min 0397: SPEED EVENT STANDING REGULATIONS – SUPERSPRINT STARTING REGULATIONS**

The Speed Event Working Group continues to work on this issue - to determine if there is a need for shorter duration Sprint and Super Sprint events where multiple vehicles can be released; either two at a time or multiple under a safety car.

### **Min 0398: MOTORKHANA TESTS BOOKLET**

The Motorkhana Tests Booklet (last publication was in 2013) is in the process of being updated, and will be available very shortly.

### **Min 0399: FLAG POINTS LISTED ON TRACK LICENCE OR ON CAMS PERMIT**

The Commission continues to work on this issue.
