SAFETY AND RISK ISSUES

Frontal Head Restraints (FHR)

The Commission requested that prior to FHR regulations coming into effect for all Speed events as from 1/1/20 that reminders of compulsory use of FHR at club events as from 1/1/20 will be issued to clubs and further releases - clarifying Schedule D (at Article 1.4) – be issued over next six months.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Min 0403: SAFETY REQUIREMENTS OF OPEN VEHICLES AT SPEED EVENTS

Safety requirements for open top vehicles at various Speed Event venues will be further assessed by CAMS through the track inspection process.

Min 0404: SPEED EVENT STANDING REGULATIONS – SUPERSPRINT STARTING REGULATIONS NCR 24B – SUPERSPRINTS

A Discussion Paper proposing a modification to starting procedures - to enable the various procedures to be documented in the Speed Event Standing Regulations - was tabled at the meeting. The Paper outlined that in recent times there has been varying operational procedures undertaken to start Super Sprint Events. Providing a clear definition in the Standing Regulations of what is permissible will remove the need for any interpretation to take place.

Following discussion the Commissioners asked for a Decision Paper to be submitted to the Face to Face Meeting on 6 July.

Min 0405: MOTORKHANA TESTS BOOKLET

Min 0406: FLAG POINTS LISTED ON TRACK LICENCE OR ON CAMS PERMIT

Flag positions requirements at various Speed Event venues will be assessed by CAMS when each venue has its Track Licence updated.
