Minute 0562: PROCESS ON APPEAL APPLICATION FOR LICENCE UPGRADES

It was previously noted by the Commissioners that there is not an appeal process for those who have been unsuccessful in their upgrading application and determined that such a process needs to be developed.

Minute 0567: JUNIOR DRIVERS REQUIRED TO CARRY OUT SESSION/S AS A TRACKSIDE OFFICIAL TO OBTAIN A PC LICENCE

Under General Regulations, Competitors Licences in the CAMS Manual the requirement to upgrade from a circuit PCC licence to PC licence requires "Within any given period prior to upgrade, participate as a non-trackside official for one eight-hour or two four-hour sessions at a CAMS Circuit Racing event. Passbook to be signed by Senior Official."

It was determined that the regulations are quite clear and there is no need for a change; Member Services are to be fully aware of this issue so the correct advice can be given to enquiries of this nature.
