BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Minute 0451: SECTOR MARSHALS / STAGE COMMANDERS ACCREDITATION (BRONZE LEVEL)

It was commented that this issue is now over to CAMS Training to prepare and introduce an upskill course for Sector Marshals to participate in – but exclude rally stage commanders as originally envisaged as it is considered the issue is not that relevant to them. As the AOC has reviewed the Sector Marshal licensing situation and is comfortable with the current situation, irrespective of the contents of a document issued at the recent Grand Prix, this matter is no longer an issue for the AOC.
